## **10. Food and drinks**

- Talk about various kinds of food and drinks

## **11. Housing**

- Divide housing into categories, type of houses in England and Czech Republic
- Compare living in the city and the village
- Describe your own house/flat and your room

## **12. British and American Literature**

- Talk about your favourite English and American authors

- Choose one book and talk about it

- Describe means of transport
- Talk about the types of accommodation

- Talk about problems you can have on your journey or holiday

- Name the difference between illnesses and civil diseases (cancer, cold, diarrhea, diabetes, etc...)
- List the types of doctors
- Try to tell about stressful situation. What does stress you the most?

- Try to classify sports from different points of view (indoor-outdoor, winter-summer, etc..)
- What sports are typical for Czechs, English and Americans?
- Talk about the sports which are played in Australia and New Zealand
